EPBC Referral

On 14 May, following Neoen's submission of an EPBC referral for the Bondo Wind Farm, the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW) confirmed that the project constitutes a "controlled action" (i.e. that it may have an impact on species or matters protected under the Federal EPBC Act).

This standard process and decision, which forms part of the planning and approvals pathway for all wind farms in Australia, confirms that the project requires approval at the federal level (under the EPBC Act) in addition to the State level (under the EP&A Act). This decision also confirmed that the NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI) would be responsible for the assessment and approval process under both regulations, in line with the existing bilateral agreement.
