**Wind Farm FAQ's****Question:**

How close can wind turbines be placed near a home?

Answer:

In NSW, under the 2024 Wind Energy Guidelines, no wind turbine can be placed closer than 1.9km to a home.

Neoen has taken this further for Bondo Wind Farm and will not place a wind turbine closer than 2.1km to a home. The only exception to this would be if a neighbour agreed to a turbine being closer.
